

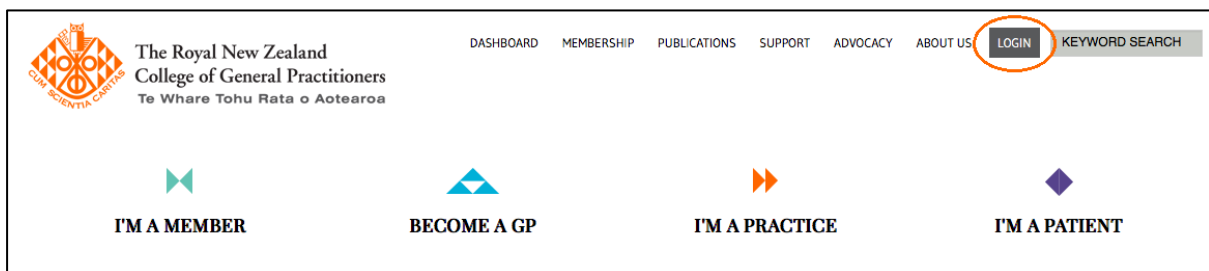


## Help guide ► Accessing BMJ

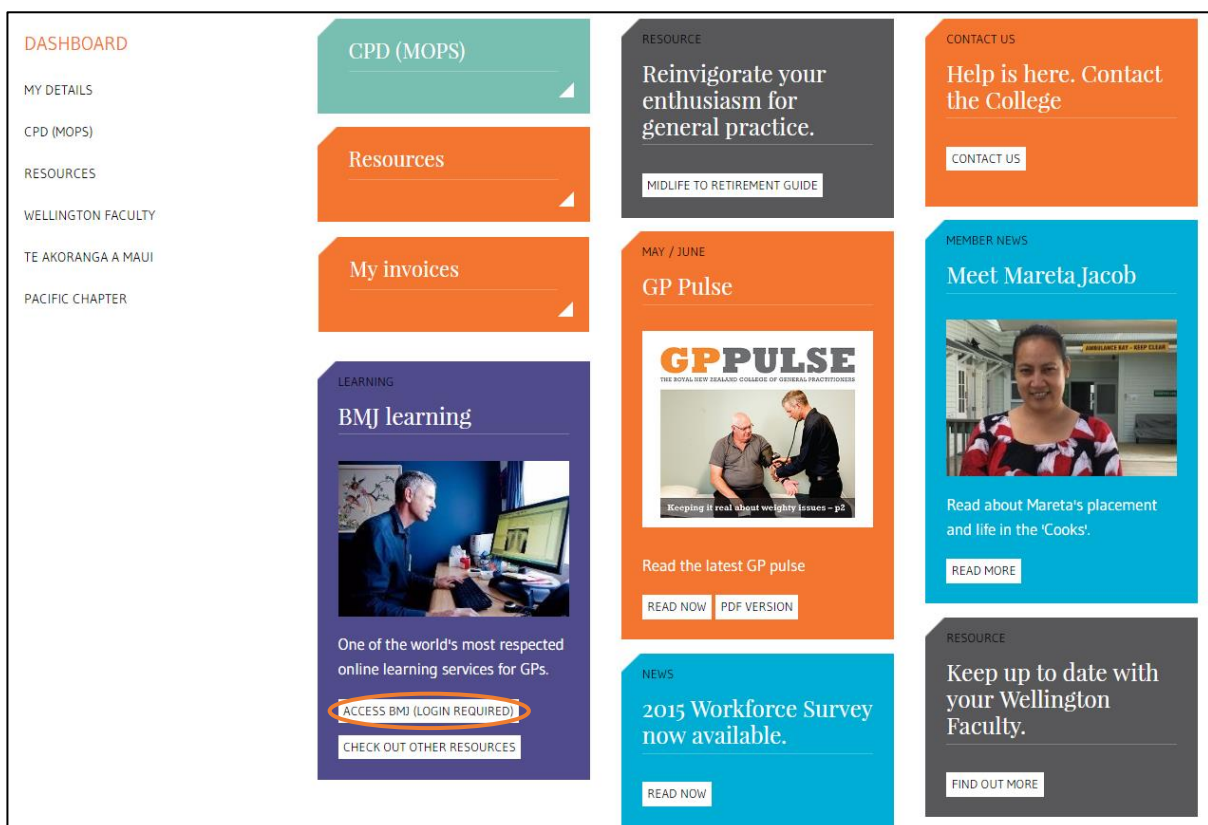
College members have free access to BMJ Learning; a world class interactive teaching platform that counts towards CPD points.

Your log-in details for BMJ remain the same.

- 1) Go to [rnzcgp.org.nz](http://rnzcgp.org.nz) and click **login** in the top right corner.



- 2) This BMJ tile is highlighted in **purple** when you log-in to your Dashboard alongside other useful resources. Click **access BMJ (login required)**.





- 3) If you are already registered with BMJ Learning, click **Sign in to BMJ Learning** and enter your username and password. You will now have access to over 500 free learning modules. If you are new to BMJ, you will need to click **register**.
