Our respiratory service is a free, community service for children and adolescents between the ages of 9 and 18 years and their families/whanau.

We provide education and action plans for children and adolescents with asthma and other respiratory disorders. This service aims to build on the strengths of identified children/taitamariki, with diagnosed asthma. So that the potential for early intervention, prevention, treatment and ongoing management is maximised and the future prospect of improved health outcome for these children/taitamariki can be achieved, while working alongside families.

Entry to service: Self/Whanau referrals, Primary Care/GP, Secondary/Tertiary health services, other health or social services referrals.

We expect the child/adolescents GP to be informed and involved as the primary medical caregiver, even if they did not make the original referral.
